Lesson Goals

- 1) to create an electronic class fraction book using Photo Story
- 2) reinforce fraction concepts learned in math class
- 3) to practice writing/typing explanatory paragraphs based on a photograph

Lesson Objectives

SOL: Math - 3.5, 3.6, 3.11; English - 3.10; Technology - C/T 3-5.2, C/T 3-5.5, C/T 3-5.8

After a brief introduction to Photo Story, students will use the software to type their explanatory paragraphs with zero errors in an effort to create a class book.

Assessment of Lesson Effectiveness
